While a certain amount of time during the day will be devoted to presentation, the majority of time will provide teachers with the opportunity to work together or individually on real lessons applying North Dakota standards in Reading and Language Arts. The focus will be primarily on developing standards based lessons that integrate academic oral language with reading and writing. Specifically, participants in the workshop will:

- Develop a greater understanding of the role of academic oral language in college and career ready standards.
- Develop skills in addressing higher order thinking skills in lesson planning.
- Consider the needs of diverse populations, including English Learners, Ethnic Minorities and Students with Disabilities, in standards based lesson planning.
- Using state standards, develop an interactive reading lesson for fiction and informational texts, with follow through writing activities.
