## **RESP Strategic Planning**

The RESP Strategic Planning Event was held on February 21, 2012. The day involved 40 representatives from 17 different RESP districts. Facilitator Marv Erhard introduced the strategic planning process and presented the results of the needs survey. This survey identified three issues that were explored during the planning event: 1) customization 2) core services 3) changing demographics. District representatives met in subgroups to discuss these issues and consider possible strategies, actions and assessments for each concern. Following the Planning Event, Mr. Erhard summarized the proposed strategies into a survey that allows participants to prioritize the actions. This survey was emailed to all Strategic Planning participants with their input due by March 9. A list of the top priorities from the districts will be presented to the Governing Board for consideration in the near future.

The Strategic Planning Event was a powerful day as districts shared their visions for the future of RESP. I want to thank all of those who participated in the Strategic Planning Process and extend a special thank you to Marv Erhard for facilitating this day. Together, we can do more.
